Playing celestial music in concert

Cho-u Hotsu Wa Ge On

And producing harmonious, elegant sounds,

Ka Tan Sai Sho-u Son

They praise the most excellent one with verses

Ku Yo-u Mu Ryo-u Kaku

And make offerings to the Infinitely Enlightened

Ku Datsu Jin Zu-u E

'You have fully acquired supernatural powers and

wisdom,

Yu-u Nyu-u Jin Bo-u Mon

Freely entered the gates of the profound Dharma,

# Hitsu Jo-u Nyo Ze Setsu

And without fail establish lands such as mine.

# Chi Hou Nyo Den Yo-u

While knowing that things are like lightning flashes and mirages,

# Ku Kyo-u Bo Satsu Do-u

They pursue the bodhisattva path to the utmost.

#### Gu Sho Ku Doku Hon

Possessing all roots of virtue,

#### Ju Ke To-u Sa Butsu

The power of the Buddha's Primal Vow is such that

# Mon Myo-u Yoku O-u Jo-u

#### Ji Chi Fu Tai Ten

And their attainment of nonretrogression comes about of itself.

## Bo Satsu Kou Shi Gan

After paying homage to them with joy, they take their leave

# Gen To-u An Nyo-u Koku

And return to the Land of Peace.

# Nyaku Nin Mu Zen Pon

People who lack roots of good

# Fu Toku Mon Shi Kyo-u

Are not able to hear this sutra,

## Sho-u Jo-u U Kai Sha

But those who observe the precepts without fault

# Nai Gyaku Mon Sho-u Bo-u

Are able to hear the right Dharma.

# Zo-u Kyo-u Ken Se Son

Those who encountered the World - honored One in the past

# Soku No-u Shin Shi Ji

Are able to accept this teaching;

## Ken Kyo-u Mon Bu Gyo-u

Humbly receiving it and holding fast to it,

## Yu Yaku Dai Kan Gi

They dance with great joy.

Sravakas and even bodhisattvas

#### Maku No-u Ku Sho-u Shin

Are unable to know thoroughly the enlightened mind;

# Hi Nyo Ju-u Sho-u Mo-u

They are like persons born without sight

# Yoku Gyo-u Kai Do-u Nin

Desiring to guide others.

# Nyo Rai Chi E Kai

The ocean of the Tathagata's wisdom

#### Jin Ko-u Mu Gai Tai

Is deep, vast, and without limit or bottom.

## Ni Jo-u Hi Sho Shiki

It cannot be fathomed by those of the two vehicles;

# Yui Butsu Doku Myo-u Ryo-u

Only Buddhas alone can fully comprehend it.

## Ke Shi I Sai Nin

Even if all human beings,

#### Gu Soku Kai Toku Do-u

Without exception, fully attained the Way,

## Soku Ga Zen Shin Nu

That person is my true friend;

#### Ze Ko To-u Ho Chi

Therefore, awaken aspiration for enlightenment.

#### Setsu Man Se Kai Ka

Even if the whole world were filled with fire,

#### Hi Ka Yo-u Mon Bo-u

Resolutely pass through it in your quest to hear the Dharma.

You will unfailingly attain the enlightenment of Buddha
